- Not possess any hydroponic growing equipment or other drug paraphernalia.
- Not possess any cell phones, pagers or other portable wireless communication devices.

- Not possess any weapon as defined by the *Criminal Code*.

- Abide by and be amenable to the reasonable rules of the household.
- Seek and maintain gainful employment

- Report forthwith upon release to the Bail Program, 50 Eagle St. W., Newmarket and thereafter as required or as follows

Weapons Prohibition

- Does not possess any firearm, cross-bow, prohibited weapon, restricted weapon, prohibited device, ammunition, prohibited ammunition or explosive substance.
- Does not possess or apply for any authorization, licence or registration certificate relating to the above-named items.
- Surrenders all above-named items and every authorization, licence and registration certificate related thereto in his/her possession as follows: _____

_____ but assuming it would otherwise apply, s. 115 of the Criminal Code shall not apply in this order.
