Re: Confirmation of Motions

To all litigants/counsel involved in matters in the Superior Court of Justice, Family Branch at Newmarket,

If motions are not confirmed in accordance with the *Family Law Rules* and the Central East Region Practice Direction, it will be presumed by the judiciary that these motions are not proceeding and preparatory time will be allocated to other matters. It should be presumed that the judiciary will not allow an unconfirmed matter to proceed on the scheduled date.

For clarification, motions under one hour require confirmation by 2:00 p.m. three days prior to the hearing.

Motions in excess of one hour require confirmation by 2:00 p.m. seven days prior to the hearing.
